

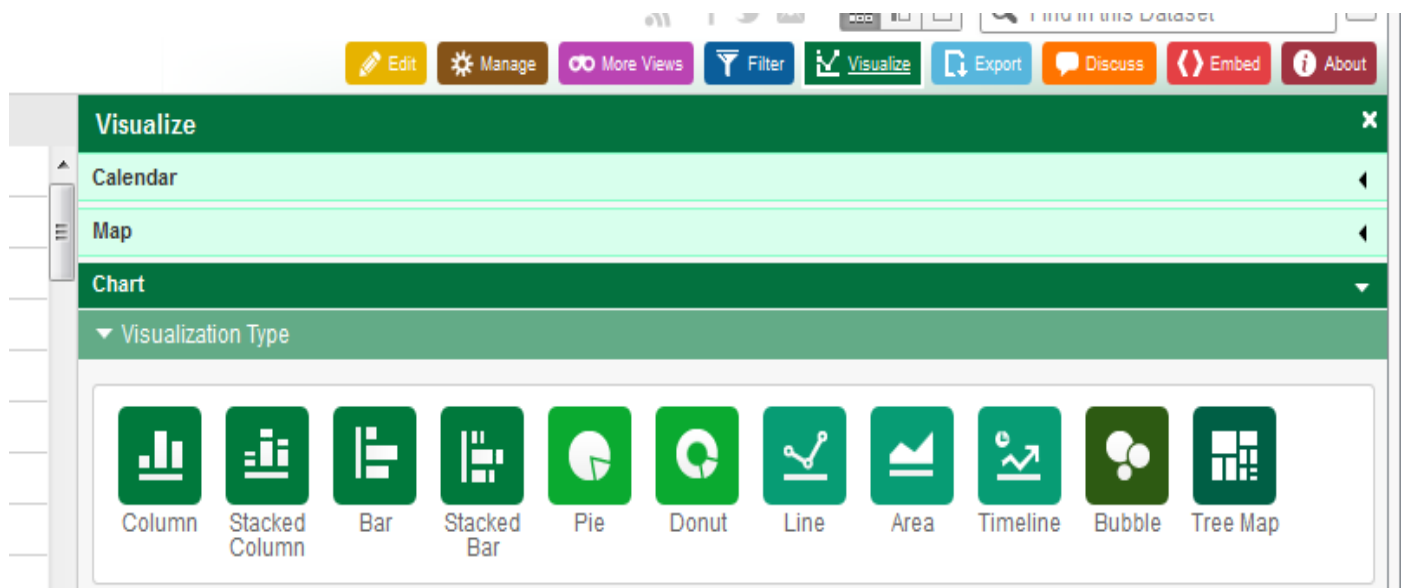
Creating a Donut Chart

How do I create a donut chart?

To create a chart, select a filtered view or dataset

Select the Visualize button in the upper right hand corner of a view or dataset.

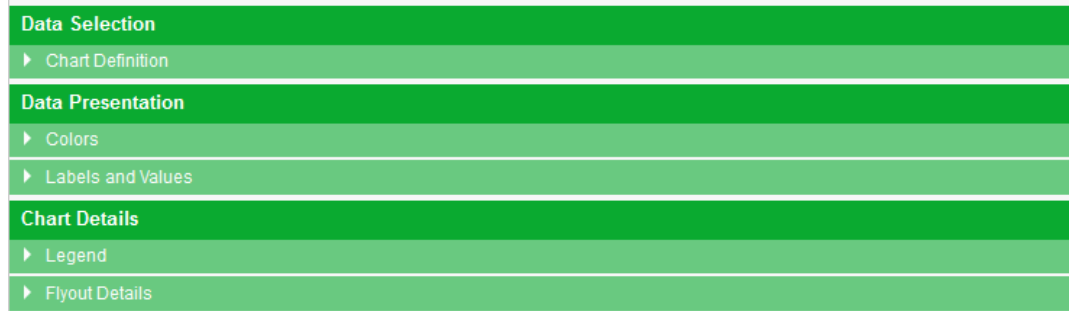


Select donut chart: Donut

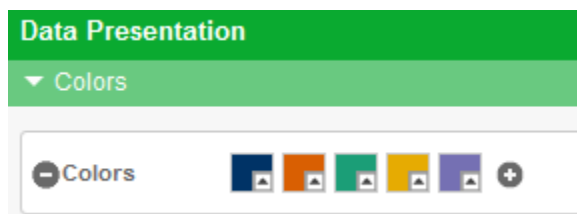
The options for this chart type are



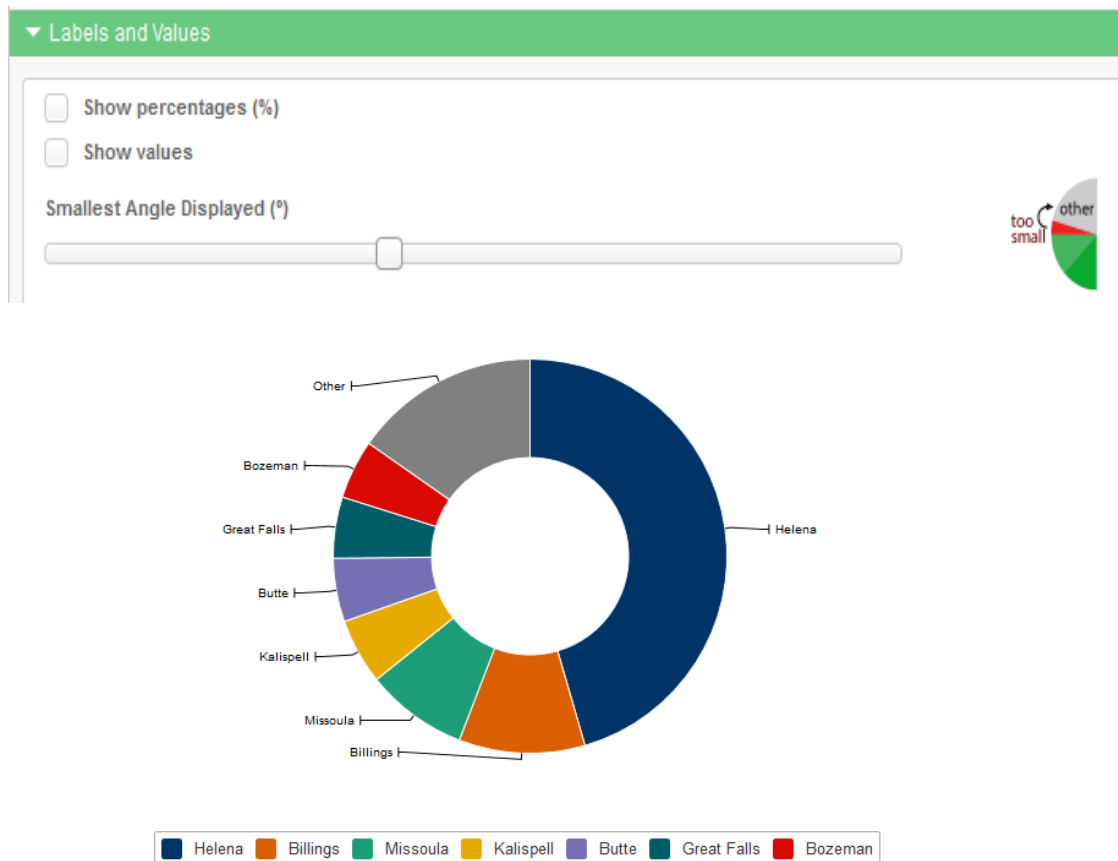
Under Chart Definition, Choose the label and value of the data. (For this example, we selected city name and current rent).



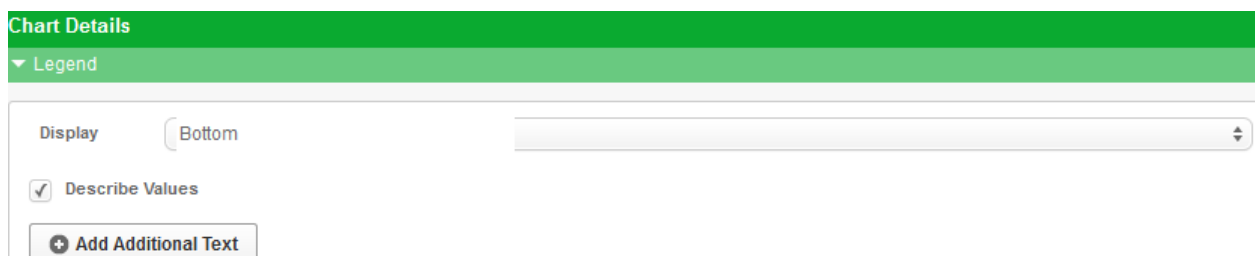
Under the Data Presentation Colors Selection, Options to change the color are available



Under the Data Presentation Labels and Values Selection, There are options to include labels, show percentages instead, or set the smallest angle of the chart, which will wrap up smaller data values based on your selection into an 'other' category.



Under the Chart Details Legend Selection, You can select where you would like the legend to display and if you would like series descriptions to display.



Under the Chart Details Flyout Details Selection, Select which data points will display when you click on the data point.

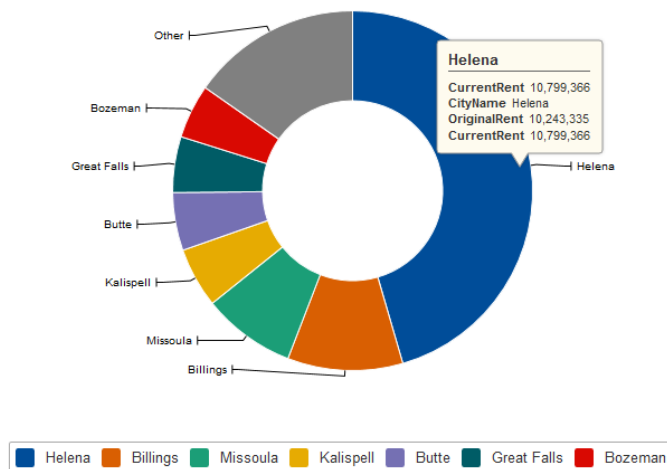
